( )	OctoberFest Fundraiser (October 25th 2019): In the past the band has hosted a Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser in
	March. We have a need to raise \$9,000 by December 20th to pay the deposit for 70 additional marching band
	uniforms that we need to outfit the band for Fall 2020, so we need to begin raising funds this fall. Parents are
	needed to provide input to shape our event including booking an off-site venue (this will be a 21+ older event),
	silent auction, set up/clean up, decorations, ticket sales, and advertising.
()	<u>Uniform Alterations:</u> This year, we have the biggest band we've ever had! This is exciting, but means that we
	are really stretching to get every student into a marching uniform that fits them. Many students will need their
	uniforms hemmed, tacked, etc. We need parents who are willing to help with the alterations.
( )	<u>Uniform Crew:</u> Assisting our uniform manager in fitting uniforms during band camp. We also use volunteers to
	help students get into uniform at games & competitions.
( )	<u>Uniform Campaign:</u> Since our band is larger than ever this year and is only expected to keep growing we need
	to launch a uniform campaign to raise \$26,000 to cover the cost of purchasing an additional 70 uniforms so that
	we have enough uniforms for the Fall 2020 season. We need parent volunteers to serve together with Ms. Bounds
	to generate donations for this cause. Together we can raise these funds in a short period of time!
( )	<b>Bookkeeper(s):</b> All of our bands funds are deposited and processed through Sheldon High School and 4J school
	district. However, it greatly assists if we have parents volunteer assisting with bookkeeping. Examples include
	tracking funds turned in via fundraising and funds paid/earned for trips. The bookkeeping can all be done
	remotely and on your own time schedule!
